


Celebrating God's Faithfulness

We praise God for how He is using Audio Scripture Ministries (ASM) to bring His love and His Word to people around the world who desperately need to hear the truth of the Gospel!

ASM was founded in 1967 by Dr. Ron Beery, and was known then as Portable Recording Ministries. The years have brought incredible changes in technology, and the global mission landscape, but ASM's focus has remained—providing the Bible in audio so that every person has the opportunity to hear God's Word in their own language.

Over these five decades, ASM has empowered and equipped national teams who record the Bible and Bible engagement resources in:

- Africa (68 resources, in 67 languages)
 - » Mozambique (producing an additional 16 resources, in 12 languages)
- India (72 resources, in 76 languages)
- Mexico (47 resources, in 85 languages)

Because of people like you who are praying and giving, thousands of men, women, and children are listening to God's Word in audio. Lives are being changed, families are being reunited, communities are being transformed, and churches are being planted, to the glory of God. It is our prayer that this 2017–18 Fiscal Year Report is an encouragement, as together we celebrate God's faithfulness.

350+ DISTRIBUTION PARTNERS

More than 350 individuals, couples, churches, or organizations have served as the hands and feet of Christ and hand-delivered audio Bibles to people who need them. The need for God's Word in audio is great, as nearly 80% of the people alive today are oral learners, who can't, don't, or won't read (orality.net).



Meet Rosa. About 20 years ago, her husband, Juan, helped translate and then record the Bible with us in the Chinantec language. Juan has since passed away, but Rosa continues this work, connecting people to God's Word in their heart language!

Many audio Bibles have been distributed throughout Mexico because of their work. Sometimes past recipients bring back a much-loved, decade-old audio Bible so we can replace the batteries or update it, so they can keep listening to God's Word.

Please pray for Rosa and our other national partners—and that all of the people in the 250+ language groups of Mexico would soon be able to hear the Bible in their own heart language!

600 PASTORS EQUIPPED

with audio Bibles to help them minister to their congregations and encourage local outreach.



2,630 AUDIO BIBLES

distributed to the people of Mexico, including 612 Proclaimers for group listening of an average of 40 people at a time, and 2,018 individual listening units.



Jim and Jamie Loker, ASM Latin America Directors, hosted **50 people** in short-term teams for community work and audio Bible distributions. Through these teams, ASM provided food, water filters, building materials, tarps, community kitchens, helped build a children's ministry center, and shared many audio Bibles with those impacted by the major 2017 and 2018 earthquakes in southern Mexico.

RADIO EQUIPMENT

supplied for a low-wattage radio station in Yalalag that broadcasts audio Scripture.

"I have a Bible, but I can't read it," Paulo told our team in November 2018. Paulo, an elderly Mozambican man, was sitting near his hut when Chad Vanden Bosch presented him with an audio Bible in Shona and Portuguese. Paulo showed Chad the print Bible that he had received many years ago—a children's picture Bible in Dutch. He had memorized all the pictures, since he couldn't read it. As a local pastor, Paulo says his new audio Bible will allow him to hear God's Word, understand it, and more effectively teach others about God.

Pray for Paulo as he shares God's Word with others—and for the many people in Mozambique still waiting and eager to hear God's Word in audio!

In November 2018, Chad Vanden Bosch, ASM Africa Director, began working with a team of Mozambicans on a Bible-based agricultural project, as a way to connect people with God's Word while addressing the vital issue of food security. Pray this project would help overcome low harvest yields and bring openness to the Gospel message, as local farmers listen to audio Bibles during their hours in the fields.

25 CURRENT PATIENTS

in the Compassionate Care Program, who receive weekly palliative care visits from the team, along with health resources and spiritual care.



Since the Compassionate Care Program was started by Dara Vanden Bosch in 2015, she and her team of 3 Mozambican women have made 2,375+ palliative care visits, and have ministered to 103 total patients. This team works hard to provide for patients' physical needs through palliative care, as well as spiritual care through prayer, praise songs, and audio Scripture.



3 EDUCATION RECORDINGS

completed in the Tewe language to help patients learn about HIV/AIDS, malaria, and diarrhea—to help them stay healthy.



15 AUDIO BIBLES

given to new patients in their heart language to help them come to faith or grow in their faith in Jesus Christ.

How does a bicycle repairman in India serve God? For Jithin (pseudonym), the answer was clear. When he received an audio Bible, he not only wanted to listen to God's Word daily—he knew God had called him to help connect others to God's Word.

While he cheerfully works to repair his clients' bicycles, Jithin now boldly plays audio Scriptures with a speaker he attached to his bicycle. "Some laugh and mock," Jithin shared with a quiet smile, "but others listen very attentively." Hearing the Bible in his own language brings joy and hope that cannot be contained, and Jithin is eager to share it with those around him!

Pray for the Holy Spirit to prepare hearts as Jithin, and many others in India, share the good seed of God's Word with those who need to hear.





Every person who wants to hear God's Word should have the opportunity to do so in their own heart language.
