ASM helps connect people to God's Word in their own heart language by recording and distributing Bible and Bible engagement resources in audio.

We serve a great God, and I am indeed filled with joy in reporting what He has done in, and through, Audio Scripture Ministries (ASM) during 2019!

We praise God for the way He is leading ASM, so all may hear the Good News of Jesus.

This year, in both Mexico and Mozambique, **ASM teams helped distribute more audio Bibles than ever before.** God used your prayers and financial support to make this happen!

Early in 2019, two cyclones hit Mozambique. In the midst of massive devastation, food security and sanitation issues, Chad and Dara Vanden Bosch (ASM Africa Director, ASM Compassionate Care Coordinator, respectively) **ministered to hundreds of people who were spiritually and physically hungry, and who had desperate medical needs.** God also led Chad to begin a **new farming ministry—New Harvest Farm—**to address ongoing food security issues in the region. Through the generosity of donors, **ASM was able to send a 40-foot shipping container with audio Bibles, medical supplies, and agricultural equipment** to Mozambique. Thank you!

God has opened **new doors** to begin Bible recording and distribution partnerships in Central and South Asia (country names withheld for security reasons), and to **explore expanded ministry** in Guatemala, Haiti, and Uganda. We're also working to distribute audio Bibles in correctional / prison settings, and in West Michigan to migrant workers, immigrants, and refugees. **God is good!**

We hope you'll be encouraged by this report, and consider how God might use you to share His Word with those who need to hear it in 2020, and beyond!

WHY AUDIO?



Imagine that your community is dying from a devastating illness. You have the cure in your hands, yet it's written in a language that is **unintelligible** to you, and there's **no access** to a translator or technology to help you understand the cure. Imagine your anguish and frustration.

For millions of people who are oral communicators by necessity or preference, that's what it's like when their only access to God's Word is a print Bible in a language they don't know, or can't read. **They need God's Word** because it is life and hope; yet the Bible remains hidden and inaccessible.

Since 1967, Audio Scripture Ministries (then known as Portable Recording Ministries International) has focused on **reaching oral communicators with the Good News of Jesus**.

We believe that **every person** has a need, and a right, to hear God's Word in a culturally and contextually appropriate language and format.

Millions are still waiting to hear the Good News, and we should not wait to share it. Now is the time.



How does receiving access to God's Word in audio change lives? **Maria** was born in Guatemala with very poor eyesight, and did not learn how to read. She also has a minimal understanding of Spanish, because her heart language is **Kiche**.

ASM, through partner Marty Quigley, was part of providing an audio Bible to Maria and her daughter (*pictured*).

Maria was **instantly thrilled**, captivated as a new world opened to her to hear God's word in **Kiche**. As Maria and her daughter walked home that day, Maria wouldn't let go of her audio Bible and kept it pressed to her ear, listening intently to God's Word.

We praise God for each ASM donor who helped provide **solar-powered audio Bibles to people like Maria**, who treasure their audio Bibles and let God's Word dwell in them richly! How many more people will be blessed as they listen daily and in turn share God's Word with others? Thank you for supporting ASM's work to record God's Word and provide it to those who, like Maria, are so eager to hear. What will He do through you in 2020, for those still waiting?

“I used to be horrible to my wife... **but I am changing as I listen to the audio Bible,**” Luis boldly shared with our team in Mozambique.

God’s Word is powerful, and everything ASM does is to help **connect people to the Bible in an accessible way** so they too can know that life-transforming power. Praise God that Luis and his wife Luisa (*pictured*) received an audio Bible through ASM’s Compassionate Care program in Mozambique. Now, after hours and hours of listening to the Bible, Luis testifies to the transformation of his life and marriage: “I think the devil was standing in our relationship, **but now things have changed!**”

God has promised: “So shall **My Word** be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it **shall accomplish what I please**, And it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it” (Isaiah 55:11, NKJV).

God is working in Luis and Luisa’s lives—and in lives globally—through the Bible in audio. “The fields are ripe unto harvest” and **good fruit like this is the result**, as ASM shares audio Scripture players with people across the world through trusted local pastors and national partners.



AUDIO BIBLE DISTRIBUTION





“It’s great when you come [on a short-term trip] and tell Bible stories, but **once you go, they forget**, or still have questions, and need to hear it again. **That’s why audio Bibles are so important!**” observed a national partner in Ghana.

A Dagomba man in Northern Ghana received an audio Bible while he was sick, brought to him by ASM partner *Mango Tree Ministries*. **After listening to the audio Bible, he committed his life to Jesus—despite the antagonistic response of his brother**, the village chief, who had earlier thrown his own son out of the village for also turning to Jesus. Shortly after receiving Jesus, this man died peacefully. His family held a meeting regarding his belongings, asking: “Does anyone want to keep this audio Bible?” In the silence, his mother, the regional chief’s wife, spoke up boldly: “**I do.**” She unashamedly explained that **she also had been listening** to the audio Scriptures playing in her language, **and had decided to follow Jesus, too!**

As a result, *Mango Tree Ministries* has received permission from the chief to come back to this previously-hostile village. They are starting a children’s group and other work there through national partners. **God’s Word is alive and active and continues to transform lives and communities!**

Praise God for each one of the thousands of audio Bibles loaded and sent from the ASM Resource Department in Holland, MI. We thank God for ministries like *Mango Tree* who strategically distribute audio Bibles throughout the world, just like the one listened to by the Dagomba man and his mother.

INTEGRAL MISSION



Integral Mission is a new term we're using to express a commitment to **reaching all aspects of a person's life with the Good News of Jesus**. Sometimes termed "holistic mission," U.K. theologian Dr. Chris Wright says "[Integral Mission] emphasizes that in our mission activities we must address the whole of human need—physical, material, intellectual, emotional, social, and spiritual—not just the last of these." Indeed, our Lord is the perfect example of addressing all these human needs during His time on earth.



ASM's core ministry activity is **recording and distributing the Bible and Bible Engagement Resources in audio**. Yet, in many areas where we record and distribute, real human needs are overwhelming—extreme poverty, empty bellies and no hope for relief, and life-threatening medical conditions.

As you read of **New Harvest Farm**, or learn how the **Compassionate Care program** provides hospice and palliative care, or of tangible disaster relief following cyclones in Mozambique or earthquakes in Mexico, know that every effort is earnestly prayed about and evaluated based on **sharing God's Word with more people, and helping it take root in communities**.



New Harvest Farm, an outreach to Mozambique subsistence farmers, opens hearts in the community to hear about the Creator God who loves them. **Compassionate Care** demonstrates Jesus' care for every aspect of their life. **Disaster relief** gives evidence of God's heart for the hurting and displaced.

God is opening incredible ministry doors for ASM, and **we remain committed to the preeminence of His Word**. Prayerfully and carefully, we're stewarding the resources He's entrusted to our care, **so more people may hear God's Word and see its impact** on all aspects of human need.

COMPASSIONATE CARE

Augusto is a miracle! Earlier this year, our Compassionate Care Team learned of Augusto whose leg wound was so severe that everyone, including his family and community, thought he would die or have major complications. Our teams around the world prayed for Augusto, Dara Vanden Bosch's team administered basic medical care, and **we waited for God to intervene—and He did!** Today Augusto stands as a testament to God's healing touch, as God used the team to offer hope through medical care, and a life-giving audio Bible, which Augusto listened to faithfully. Dara reports **Augusto is a "changed man,"** adding that the community "was so sure he would die. Now they say God is with Mvura Ya Upenhu Palliative Care. People get better with them."

INTEGRAL MISSION



“This could transform our whole community!” said a local leader enthusiastically in August at the first-ever agricultural training held by New Harvest Farm (NHF). This community leader was one of many leaders who gave Chad Vanden Bosch their support for establishing NHF—and **transformation is underway!**

Chad says the fifteen-acre NHF seeks “Restoration that brings a New Harvest,” as they help restore the soil, restore relationships with our Creator God, and restore hope through biblically-based farming techniques. NHF’s “Farming with God” hands-on training program uses three pillars of agriculture: **Technology, Management, and Faith.** Chad and his team have recorded the agricultural lessons so that **each graduate receives an audio player with a Bible**, the lessons, Scriptural songs, and other teachings.

Pray indeed for a New Harvest of souls!





Cyclone Idai devastated central Mozambique in March 2019. Through the generosity of ASM donors and numerous partners, God opened the door to send a 40-foot container filled with audio Bibles, agricultural equipment, and medical supplies to Chad and Dara Vanden Bosch and their teams—providing much-needed resources to better serve the people of Mozambique.

SHORT-TERM TRIPS MAKE LONG-TERM IMPACT

In 2019, ASM Latin America Directors **Jim and Jamie Loker hosted 29 people** on five different short-term mission trips in Mexico. These trips, held in collaboration with Mexican Christian leaders and U.S. churches or ministries, such as Grace Family Church (*pictured middle left*) and Community of Hope, share God’s Word by **hand-delivering audio Bibles where they are most needed**. These short-term mission teams make a **lasting investment as they share God’s Word**, traveling to rural destinations alongside local pastors and community leaders, and experiencing the joy of providing the Bible in someone’s own heart language.

We thank God for partners like Galcom USA. Galcom regularly brings teams with audio Bibles and also provides local broadcasters with training and technology to start or maintain low-wattage community radio stations (*pictured bottom left*). These stations are a highly-effective tool **to more widely share the audio Scripture ASM has recorded**, reaching people in remote areas.

A CONTAINER-SIZED GROUP EFFORT

What does it take to send a 40-foot container 11,000 miles across land and ocean with crucial ministry tools and supplies? **Prayer, first and foremost, then the generosity of God's people ... followed by hours of gathering, cleaning, labeling, organizing, welding, knitting, quilting, crocheting, packing, sawing, banding, loading, fastening, and more praying (and sweating!), by 27+ volunteers and many churches.**

Only God can know the full value this container's contents of audio Bibles, agricultural equipment, and medical supplies will bring in our ministry to and with the people of Mozambique. Praise God for the doors that are already opening in the community since the container's arrival in December!

We thank God for **Loren Brouwer** (and his team) from **Overisel Reformed Church** (Holland, MI), who served as volunteer Container Coordinator, investing hundreds of hours locating and preparing agricultural equipment and supplies, and managing the logistics of packing and shipping with Straightway, Inc. (Warren, MI). **Kristen Worst** from **Westend Christian Reformed Church** (Grand Rapids, MI) coordinated the medical supplies. Other partners included the **Reformed Church in America-Global Mission, InTouch Ministries, Ambassadors for Christ Connecting, MegaVoice, Global Health Ministries, Family Farm and Home** (Holland, MI), **Global Samaritan Resources, Hamilton Distributing Company, ABWE, First Reformed Church of Holland, Paul's Pharmacy** (Holland, MI), **Our Savior Lutheran Church** (Federal Dam, MN), **Sew Sew Mission Sisters, Jamestown Reformed Church, and many other prayer partners, organizations, and individuals who gave generously!** **Holland Litho Printing Services and Mission Network News** also helped ASM get the word out about the post-cyclone needs in Mozambique and this Container Project.

MEGAVOICE AUDIO BIBLES

ASM can load these portable 2-ounce players with multiple Bibles/languages, perfect for listening with a small group or personally with headphones. Its lithium battery can be recharged by solar power or a standard electrical wall charger.



SMARTPHONE APPS

Scripture Earth apps (Wycliffe Canada) bring audio Scripture and Bible text to mobile devices, and the 5Fish App (Global Recordings Network) delivers Bible stories by audio/films in thousands of languages.



FAITH COMES BY HEARING PROCLAIMERS

These larger audio devices are designed to play Scripture for listening groups of 40-50 people. If no electricity is available, the battery can be recharged by the built-in solar panel or hand crank.



GALCOM IMPAX PLAYER

This durable audio Bible player can also play AM/FM radio when it's fix-tuned to any local Christian radio station frequency. It is powered by AA rechargeable batteries or the built-in solar panel.

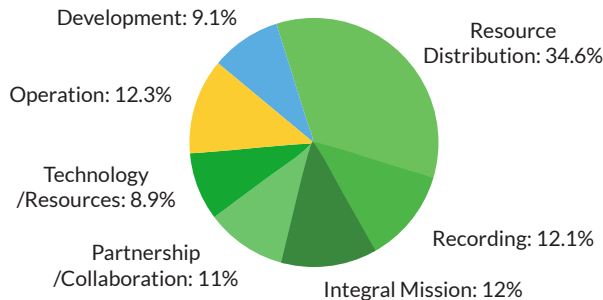

2018–19 INCOME: \$1,059,315

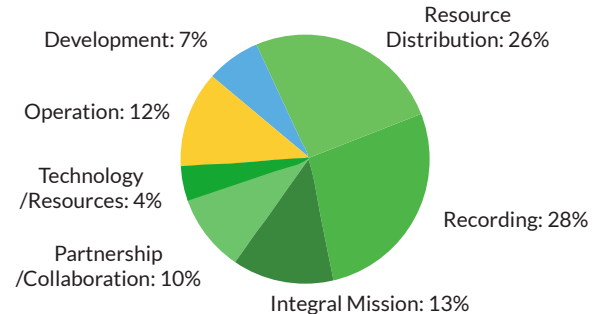
2018–19 EXPENSES*
