At the center of each partnership is our deep commitment that "... this Gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations," (Matthew 24:14a, NIV).

John 17: 20-23 records Jesus' prayer that His followers (that means us!) would be united, to the glory of God. What a beautiful reminder that our unity as believers is an inward reflection of our heart's commitment to Jesus, and an outward demonstration to the world that God loves them.

 100 audio Bibles distributed in a Western Ethiopia orphanage and through a traveling evangelist—a partnership, with the generous support of an Alabama church, giving the Gospel to younger generations in Ethiopia and South Sudan, many of whom have been traumatized by regional violence.  200 SD card audio Bibles sent to national pastors and others in nomadic people groups in Northern Kenya—a partnership, supported by your generosity to the Audio Bibles Where Most Needed fund to train pastors to share the Gospel and better serve their congregations.

- Free access to 80 different languages of audio Bible recordings (primarily languages on the continent of Africa)—a partnership with an audio Bible recording ministry, helping ASM share the Gospel in many more languages with those who need to hear.
- 2021 Mozambique Container Project providing audio Bibles, agricultural equipment, medical supplies, and humanitarian goods—a partnership, with some 50 churches, businesses and individuals, sharing the Gospel in Word and Deed in Mozambique.

You've likely heard the African proverb, "If you want to go fast, go alone. If you want to go far, go together." With our eyes on Jesus, God is calling us to "go far" together into more **Gospel Partnerships** so that His Name will be proclaimed in new regions, to new language groups, using new technology, overcoming all barriers, and in every part of the world.

During their initial visit she couldn't even find the desire to turn on her new audio Bible.

Over a month later, the team visited again, only to hear a strange voice echoing across Roda's packed-dirt clearing. Who was with Roda? Later, as they shared the Gospel message with her, she responded, "Yes, yes—I know, my [audio Bible] says that!"

Praise God that **His Word broke through** the misery of Roda's everyday life, to persistently shine hope, joy and love!

"Can you imagine—not having the Psalms?" Availability of the full Bible in audio is something God has been putting on the hearts of Jim and Jamie Loker, ASM's Latin America Directors. While the Old Testament (OT) in Spanish is available and may be understood by some, heart language translations of the OT have not yet been completed for many people groups in Mexico. Without this heart-language OT access, many miss the joy of hearing God's story in its full context.

Praise God for how He has recently opened the door for the ASM Mexico Team and Bible translation ministry partners to collaborate on several OT projects. One is the translation and recording of the OT in the Nopala Chatino language. This project brought so much excitement to the community that



nearly 80 people in the village are involved in the recording! This has been a wonderful opportunity for people to participate in the process of proclaiming God's Word, giving them a sense of ownership of the recording, and increasing their desire to share it with others.

**Please pray** for the logistics of this multi-voice, team-effort recording. Pray also for **more audio recordists** for the Mexico Team and for wisdom in prioritizing the recordings waiting to be started.

### 2,698 CUBIC FEET OF LOVE



What real difference can one hand-knitted hat make in someone's life? The 3 or 4 hours you invested in knitting, choosing just the right yarn and pattern, praying for the person who will wear it, is making a difference in Mozambique. "People here in rural Mozambique often feel like they're forgotten," explains Chad Vanden Bosch, ASM Africa Director. You are helping Chad, and his wife, Dara, change that!

This May, you helped fill a 40-foot shipping container with 2,968 cubic feet of love. From handmade hats and blankets to crucial recording tools, medical supplies, and agricultural equipment, it's a practical expression of love and help that will equip the Vanden Bosch family and ASM teams in Mozambique. Chad and Dara will be able to say "... a friend in West Michigan, or a church in South Holland, IL, or someone else that you don't know, did this for you. Because they want you to know that JESUS loves you, and we have not forgotten about you!"
