ASM's Bible Engagement Director, Tara Rye was asked earlier this year by a Ugandan leader to teach local pastors Biblestory-centric discipleship techniques. These pastors were **eager to attend** and waited

patiently for the day of training to arrive. Yet on that day, many could not attend because of technical issues. One pastor was even interrupted repeatedly by a neighborhood rooster that kept crowing loudly every time he tried to speak.

By the end of the training, Tara reports that **only two leaders** were left. **But it only took two.** These two remaining pastors were so inspired that the same day they **gathered the others to immediately re-teach what they'd learned.** Praise God!

Pastor Joseph exclaimed that the training "really makes the Bible go into your heart." Pastor Herbert added, "I will use this every day... in my community and daily life. I am going to teach and use this method to encourage!" Please be praying for Pastor Joseph, Pastor Herbert, and the many other pastors seeking Biblical training to better understand God's Word and to teach it to their congregations.

Now Tara is planning additional Zoom training to help serve, resource and equip these pastors. But next time, hopefully without the rooster!

NEW BIBLE FILMS





Praise God for how your investment in Bible recording is expanding the spread of the Gospel—now through Bible films dubbed in many indigenous languages of Mexico! Jim and Jamie Loker, ASM Latin America Directors, share that people are now watching these Bible films on their phones or via flash drives that connect to their televisions.

In 2021 the ASM Mexico Team dubbed 9 episodes of the "Deditos" videos produced by our Guatemala partner Viña Studio. These creative Bible tellings use "finger actors" to convey stories in a simple and fun way. The resulting Zapotec Bible story videos have been joyfully received by families in the community, and the team is now dubbing these videos in other languages of Mexico.

In January, the ASM Mexico team also celebrated the completed audio dubbing of the Genesis film (produced by Cru), in Mazatec of Eloxochixtlan.

The Lokers also work with local partners to share Lumo films (pictured below) that use Gospel recordings in languages that our team has completed. These films use visually-dramatized scenes overlaid with word-for-word Scripture narration. There are now

Lumo films in 80+ languages of Mexico, many recordings for which you've prayed!

God is expanding the reach of His Word through these new Gospel tools. Thank you for helping God's Word go forward in ever-expanding formats. Pray for open hearts as more people receive these Bible films and hear God's story and His redemptive work.





CLEAR HOPE IN PRISON



Alaska is considered by many to be America's "last frontier" because of its vast untamed beauty. Yet like many states, the last frontier struggles with high prison recidivism. Alaska Prison Chaplain Scott Thomas says more than two thirds of inmates in Alaska "are reincarcerated within 3 years," which he attributes to spiritual and physical issues, including "lack of community support, housing, and opportunity." COVID-19 precautions have further isolated these men and women, canceling most prison Bible studies and

other outreach efforts. The need for hope and help is great to reach the nearly 2,000 men and women in Alaska's correctional system.

We praise God that **His Word is bringing change and hope to inmates** through partners like Chaplain Scott and his wife, Kelly, who started Faith Recovery Fellowship in 2014. They are seeing the Gospel of Jesus change lives, time and time again in Alaska!

In 2021, Chaplain Scott received official approval to distribute specially-designed clear plastic audio Bibles to inmates (pictured) at one of the prison facilities. Ten "clear" audio Bibles were "gobbled up immediately" by the inmates, according to Chaplain Scott, who says they quickly distributed 10 more and then started a waiting list. Now half of the men in the facility are listening to God's Word on their own audio Bible. Praise the Lord!

These audio Bibles were also designated as individual "Property" so the men are **able to keep them upon their release from prison**. Pray for lasting change in their lives as they hear and apply God's Word both inside and outside the prison walls!

At age 15, Edi Martinez began working with Jim and Jamie Loker in Mexico. Born and raised in Mitla, Oaxaca, Edi has a passion for bringing God's Word to the many people groups of Mexico, in their own heart language.

After joining the ASM Mexico team, Edi quickly learned recording techniques and helped with various projects. Since that time, he has traveled widely, faithfully serving

as a recording technician. Most recently he handled the final on-site recordings for the New Testament recordings in Mixtec San Juan Colorado and Mazatec de Ayautla.

His flexibility and willingness to serve wherever needed are a great asset to the ASM Mexico Team. A shining example of his hard work was helping coordinate 2021's multi-voice recording of the Old Testament in the Nopala Chatino language. He helped record the 70+ people from

Nopala who participated, most of whom did not read and had to listen to another reader and then repeat their own lines!

We praise God for Edi's years of faithful ministry recording God's Word! Pray for strength, safety and God's wisdom as Edi records in villages or edits in the studio.


