But his face lit up when he saw the audio Bible. "Now you have saved me!" he exclaimed.

That's the time between when Aanshi's\* husband came to faith in Jesus, and when he was brutally murdered. His "crime"? Proclaiming Jesus boldly to everyone he knew. Abhoy\* had received forgiveness and hope through Jesus, leading him to joyfully ask each person, "Do you know Him?"

Tragically, Abhoy's life on earth was **cut short** by those angered by his faith in Jesus. They thought by killing Abhoy and cutting out his tongue, they would silence his voice and that the name of Jesus would no longer be proclaimed. They were wrong.

Instead of cowering in fear at the devastating loss of her husband, Aanshi (pictured, above) continues boldly sharing Jesus and leading several regional house churches. "I gave up my life to the Lord, and wherever He will lead me, I will follow," she affirmed. What a testimony! Abhoy's martyrdom is now being heard around the world, giving courage to believers as they share the Gospel. What these men meant for evil, God is using for good (Genesis 50:20).

Last year, I had the privilege of meeting Aanshi before her husband came to Christ. She and five other people gathered in a remote village for Bible story training with Dr. Tara Rye, Audio Scripture Ministries (ASM) Director of Bible Engagement. As Tara and her husband Greg taught them stories from the Bible, Aanshi and the others got visibly excited as they caught the vision for sharing God's Word through storytelling. "This is simple. I can do this!" they exclaimed.

Aanshi and her friends have a printed Bible, but in their oral culture many can't read.\*\* Sharing God's Word through Bible Story-centric discipleship opened a new door for these men and women, and they are

now requesting additional discipleship training and Bible resources in audio.

## PRISON WALLS ARE TALKING



"Our prison walls are now talking—about Jesus' love and His mission to reconcile us to Himself!" Pastor Luka reported, a Marsabit Prison Chaplain. He and others are seeing God at work after a recent chaplain training program made possible through YOUR prayer and support. God's Word is spreading throughout the prisons in Kenya! Inmates are hearing Scripture ring out through

the halls of their prisons as a source of hope and truth in a difficult place.

ASM Partners **Pastor David Gargule** and **Helen Etyang** (Director of Tirrim Trust and Director of TheoVision Kenya, respectively) led this outreach and **resourced local chaplains with audio Bibles.** The prisoners are from oral communities where many **don't read.** The training program trained chaplains to tell the Gospel story and equip prisoners to retell the Bible stories—and provided a total of **150 Audio Bibles in Kiswahili and 8 other local languages**, distributed in **four area prisons**.

Jesus came to "proclaim freedom for the prisoners" (Luke 4:18, NIV). This is happening in Kenya as prisoners hear the truth of His Word in their mother tongue! Chaplain Luka reminds us, "It is only God's Word that can reform a criminal, not the walls of a prison."

Your gifts are sharing God's Word within the Kenyan justice system. Let's pray for those who are waiting to hear God's Word today.





#### **20 PEOPLE SAVED**



They couldn't wait to share their story! Katja and Jonathan told Tara Rye, ASM's Bible Engagement Director, "20 of the majority people group have come to Jesus from the solar audio Bibles, and five people have recommitted their lives to Christ!"

Katja and Jonathan's son, Gadisa (Jonathan and Gadisa pictured), is adopted from a remote East African village that speaks the Amharic language of Ethiopia.

Because of the resources YOU PROVIDED, Tara had given Gadisa three audio Bibles in Amharic. They later requested additional audio Bibles in other languages for other villages they visited last year.

In a recent email, Katja learned that many people had come to Jesus through hearing God's Word. "These are not one-per-person Bibles," Katja explained, "these are going to go to many people, to be shared widely." Join us in praying that these new believers will continue to share with many others still waiting to hear so more people will call upon the Lord and be saved.
