Miracles, earthquakes, and Mexican mole are all part of **Jim and Jamie Loker's** (ASM's Latin America Directors) **30 years** of sharing God's Word in Mexico.

"Our greatest delight is seeing the impact of the Scriptures as people hear them in audio, put them into practice, and allow the Holy Spirit to transform their hearts, lives, marriages, families, and communities," the Lokers shared. Their journey is the fruit of answered prayer.

Before God was protecting them from mudslides and eating armadillo, **He guided their adventure** when, 40 years ago, Ohioan Jim met and married Texan Jamie. Becoming full-time missionaries in 1986, Jim and Jamie first worked in Guatemala and then **Oaxaca**, **Mexico**, raising and educating their seven children along the way. After serving with Wycliffe Bible Translators and Missionary Ventures, respectively, they joined Audio Scripture Ministries in 2012.

The "Que Todos Oigan" (*That All May Hear*) studio, founded by Jim, has produced over 90 complete **New Testament audio recordings** and portions of the Scriptures in **over 100 languages of Mexico**. The ASM Mexico Team also helps reach new people groups, establish radio stations, and distribute audio-dubbed Bible Films. Praise God for the 70+ short-term team trips the Lokers have hosted or assisted with.

God has used every prayer partner, financial partner, faithful recordist, and so many others in **this Great Adventure: to share His Word.** The adventure continues, so all will hear!

# **TOGETHER ON GOD'S GREAT ADVENTURE**



The sky in Michigan's Upper Peninsula flashed with the green brilliance of the Northern Lights, as shooting stars and satellites traced their own paths. I was too young to understand all I was seeing, but even now I remember the awe—that our family was wrapped up together in an adventure in the vastness of God's universe.

Michigan's UP was where God first planted the seed that would lead me to serve His

global church. He used our family's annual vacation to grow within me a sense of adventure, and a love for different cultures and people. The languages spoken by the ocean-going sailors, the "exotic" lunch smells coming from each ship's galley, and the colorful flags waving proudly from ship sterns, opened up a wide new world for this mid-Michigan youngster.

I couldn't have imagined then how God would use ships and smells to send me on the Great Adventure serving Him... but He did! Sharing God's Word in heart languages I may never speak. Learning lessons of faith and

generosity from Christian leaders around the world. Being moved to tears by the daily sacrifice of our Christian brothers and sisters, persecuted because of their commitment to sharing the Gospel.

You, too, are part of God's Great Adventure. Your prayers and financial support of Audio Scripture Ministries (ASM) have already provided 6,940 audio Bibles this year,



supported **33 Bible Engagement Trainings** with leaders in **7 countries**, and <u>allowed</u> our team to invest in the lives of dozens of Christian leaders from Pakistan to Myanmar, from Mexico to Mozambique ... and more.

Adventure looks very different for everyone, but if you've asked Jesus into your life, you are on a Great Adventure. God's Word is clear that life is a journey (Genesis 12, Jeremiah 29, Proverbs 16, Matthew 6 and more) and that this journey isn't for the faint of heart. Just read the Apostle Paul's harrowing adventures in 2 Corinthians 11!



God promises to be with us on this Great Adventure. And, God's Word provides the road map for that adventure, reminding us that trust and obedience are essential to our journey because, "... He will make your paths straight" (Proverbs 3:5-6, NIV).

### MY FAMILY DISOWNED ME



Picking up a Bible, using an audio Bible, or listening to a Bible app may not feel risky. Yet, that same access to God's Word can be dangerous for Christian brothers and sisters around the world.

For B\*, a young South Asian leader, that's his reality. "My parents made me sign a document, officially disowning me," B\* quietly shared. Because he and his wife follow Jesus, his parents said they'll never talk to him again. ASM Bible Engagement

Director **Dr. Tara Rye** hosts **regular**, **online training sessions** where Bible Storytellers like B\* can **learn and pray with each other**. As he shared his story, several other leaders began immediately praying for him and his wife. B\* **bravely continues** to do Bible Engagement in the region. His wife serves as a Bible Translator. Despite the pressure to turn back, this couple is **fully committed** to following Jesus and sharing the Gospel.

When you pray and give to ASM Bible Engagement, you encourage and train brave men and women like B\* and K\*, bringing God's Word to others who can't yet hear it. Praise God for what He

is doing through Tara, and for the Story-Centric Discipleship course just launched, providing Tara's training on ASM's website (www.audioscripture.org/courses). This training is already being used by leaders around the world.

Pray for **God to empower B\* and K\*** and other leaders as they diligently apply this training. Ask Him **to use this course** to equip many more leaders to boldly share His Word.





### **200 PATIENTS, 10 YEARS**



God has used your prayers and support of Dara Vanden Bosch, ASM Compassionate Care (CC) Coordinator and her team, to extend Christ's love to 200 patients in rural Mozambique over the past decade. As Dara says, "It's been an adventure!"

"We were a naïve and passionate duo when Rabecca and I began," Dara comments. Rabeca, a young Mozambican, was already visiting many suffering people in her village. They saw much end-of-life suffering, and

people without any comfort for chronic symptoms and began asking how they could help. **God gave ideas** and paved the way for *Mvura Ya Upenhu* ("Living Water" in ChiTewe) Palliative Care—to minister to those without access to family support or hospital care. Soon Mariana joined, and later they added "another" Rabeca, and Dorca, for a strong team.

Today people stop them on the road, requesting they visit loved ones. Though some patients have passed away, many others have been restored to health, as God used this team.

The CC Program provides basic medication, supplies, and intervetions such as hygiene products, blankets, nutritional supplements, art projects, songs, dances, and, yes, lollipops. However, it's clear that providing dignity, loyalty, consistent tender care, and audio Bibles are the interventions that make the biggest difference. Helping each patient feel seen and known—the longing of every human heart. Your prayers and support are making a huge difference in the lives of people in Central Mozambique!
