"THIS WILL BRING REVIVAL"



"I am 68, and I have never heard these things," shared Kenyan Pastor Rafael. His excitement was contagious after being trained by ASM Bible Engagement Director Dr. Tara Rye and local Gospel Partners.

Over 110 Kenyan pastors and leaders were equipped in sharing the "Six Acts of the

Bible" which demonstrates how the Bible from Genesis to Revelation is fulfilled in the Gospel. "It is amazing that we can **now tell the whole Bible story** so simply. It [encompasses] the Gospel," marveled Pastor Daniel.

Driving over 650 miles round-trip, Tara, along with local partners David and Helen served **seven different nomadic tribes** in three locations, planting **seeds of God's Word** in the hearts of those who will nurture a bountiful Gospel harvest. The response was immediate.

"What you have done in a very short period of time will be with us... even to the next generation," declared Chief Stephen, adding, "This will

bring revival to the Rendille." The seeds of multiplication took root. One leader called later, saying, "I want to be one of your trainers."

Your support of ASM Bible Engagement is equipping pastors and Christian leaders with the tools they need to share God's Word more widely and train other leaders in God's Word.

FINDING AND REJOICING



"Koow, lamma, seyyah, affar ..." Ebele*, a Rendille woman from Northern Kenya, counted quietly, identifying each goat's familiar markings and personality. "One, two, three, four ..." **not one escaped notice.** Ebele's goats are precious, a source of milk and meat to feed her family.

Ebele (pictured, left) stopped counting. One of her goats was missing! She counted again. Where could he be?**

The Rendille are one of seven nomadic tribes in Northern Kenya, totalling over **2.5 million people**. Severe drought, massive flooding, tribal violence, and political and economic uncertainty place **great pressure** on these groups. Yet—not one escapes **God's notice**.

The Rendille, Borana, Daasanach, Gabra, Pokot, Samburu, and Turkana people—are all loved by God. The young goat herder in the bush. The elderly woman slowly drawing water, bucket by bucket from the deep borehole ... God sees and loves each one with an everlasting love (Jeremiah 31:3).

In July, your prayers and financial support shared God's Word in audio in many locations. Praise God for the opportunity to provide Bible Engagement Training for over 100 pastors in Kenya with Dr. Tara Rye (ASM Bible Engagement Director) and partners Pastor David Gargule (Tirrim Trust) and Helen Etyang (Theovision Kenya). In addition, more than 1,000 girls and young women received Biblically-based Feminine Hygiene Training by Pads4Pupils partners Danna Swartz and Emily Pederson. Thank you for your generosity in helping share God's love!

Before the team arrived, I met with Pastor David and Helen (pictured, right) to pray and plan together, seeking God's guidance and the Holy Spirit's wisdom for expanded Gospel partnership. We believe healthy ministry

partnerships are essential, giving us greater opportunity to serve together in unity with Christian brothers and sisters (John 17) for the sake of the Gospel.

Eight ministry area projects including new audio Bible recordings, expanded audio Bible distribution,



Bible Engagement training, serving prison chaplains and those incarcerated, microenterprise opportunities, and much more were identified as ways to share the Gospel among each of these seven people groups "on the move." Would you pray for discernment, open doors, and funding needed to move these projects forward, to God's glory?

Jesus told the Parable of the Wandering Sheep (Matt.18, Luke 15), reminding His disciples and religious leaders that <u>every person is precious in His sight, and no one escapes the notice of the Good Shepherd.</u> Jesus said there is <u>rejoicing</u> when a lost sheep is found, "more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent." (Luke 15:7, NIV)

Let's pray God uses these Gospel partnerships so that rejoicing increases, as more people hear God's Word and turn to Jesus, the Good Shepherd! Much has been accomplished, but many more need to know God sees them, knows their needs, and in Jesus Christ there is hope. Will you help?

A BOUNTIFUL INCREASE



God is using your prayers and financial support in Latin America! Jim and Jamie Loker, ASM Latin America Directors, report that God's Word is spreading throughout Mexico's 250+ languages.

Just as farmers tend their fields but depend on God to provide sun and rain for seeds to flourish, the Lokers see God growing Gospel seed in unexpected ways. "Every year we pray about Bible translations that may or may not be ready for recording," says Jamie.

Challenges like identifying native speakers able to read their language, scheduling **conflicts** with recording technicians, and even natural **obstacles**—from cicadas to mudslides—can impede recording progress.

Despite these barriers, God <u>always</u> provides a way for His work to continue! Recently, the Mexico Team saw a bountiful increase in completed Old Testament translations awaiting recording. This is a long-awaited answer to prayer. Praise the Lord also for the increasing number of indigenous translators taking initiative to revise and translate additional books of the Bible, opening doors for more audio Bible recordings.

Your generous provision of audio Bibles means God's Word is being sown broadly. "In the past we were forced to be very selective," they reflected, "but now through your generosity our team can more freely distribute audio Bibles to friends and neighbors of those who received the initial audio Bible devices, helping multiply the impact of God's Word throughout entire communities."

That's **the fruit of your investment**—because of you, God's Word is resounding through more Mexican villages to produce a Gospel harvest, growing God's Kingdom **one transformed life at a time.**



REAPING 20 YEARS LATER



He was a sheep herder in Peru. Salvador (not pictured) had heard about Jesus, accepted the Gospel, and was baptized in the river. "One day we came back to visit him, and heard him singing joyfully, 'Alabaré, alabaré'—filling the whole valley with praise," Dale, an ASM Gospel Partner shared. "But Salvador couldn't read, and hardly knew anything about Jesus. So back then, we had cassette tapes of the Bible in

his language and gave him those." Later, Dale and his wife, Naomi, also brought him a digital audio Bible.

Recently two of Salvador's adult sons came to visit Dale and Naomi in Colorado. "They told us: 'You gave our father an audio Bible. He brought

it home, and it has changed our whole family." That was 20+ years ago!

"It's so wonderful to see someone's face light up when they hear God's Word," Dale adds. "Especially if they can't read. We've been doing this for forty years." These Gospel Partners minister all over the world, and are eager to plant more seeds. "We're only 84 now," he notes with a grin. They have seen abundant fruit from sowing God's Word. How is God leading you, like Dale and Naomi, to invest in His Great Harvest?
